

Fully tested and approved to all thermal and structural standards, the Guardian system is a high performance insulated roof system comprising of a pre-engineered lightweight frame, two layers of rigid insulation board, internal insulated plasterboard, exterior grade plywood, vapour membrane and a choice of external tile finishes.

The uardian arm Roof Conversion ystem has been fully approved by C for use as a full replacement conservatory roof.

ou do not require regulatory approval provided that the internal doors of the existing property are not removed or if these have been removed have to be replaced.

ou do require approval if you do wish to remove the doors or wall between the house and the conservatory.






The uardian ean To is ideal to maximise space at the back of the house. The ends can either have one or to hips (slopes).







The ictorian roof can also work really well when you might not have as much space in the garden as you would like. The internal plaster finish on the roof can look really attractive with its facet front finish.






